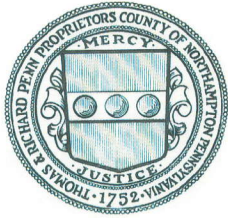

- Package and handle waste carefully to prevent spills

Adhesives	Fire extinguishers	Propane cylinders
Aerosols	Herbicides/pesticides	Thermometers
Antifreeze	Household cleaners	Thermostats
Automotive fluids & cleaners	Mercury-containing products	
Batteries (all types)	Motor oil/filters	
Compressed gas	Oil-based paint & stains	
Fluorescent light bulbs	Old gasoline/oil mixtures	
Flammables/combustibles	Pool chemicals	

No TVs or other electronics accepted

Non-hazardous materials will not be accepted

No latex paint or stains

No smoke detectors/radioactives

Accepted Scrap Metals

Recycling of residential scrap, that is primarily metal, including lawn furniture, vehicle rims/wheels, yard equipment (oil, gas & batteries removed), major metal appliances (washer, dryers, stoves), air conditioners and dehumidifiers (refrigerant does not require removal, it will be recycled), etc.

Tractor trailer \$5.50 each

No farm, bicycle, mini-bike, motorcycle, golf-cart, backhoe, etc. tires will be accepted.
