RESOLUTION APPOINTING BRADFORD T. FLYNN,  
BOROUGH MANAGER, AS PARKING CODE  
ENFORCEMENT OFFICER FOR THE BOROUGH OF BATH

**WHEREAS**, Borough of Bath (the “Borough”) is responsible for the proper enforcement and administration of its various codes and ordinances; and

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Borough enacted Ordinance No. 2005-583 on October 3, 2005, which enacted the Code of the Borough (the “Code”); and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 111 of the Code is entitled “MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC”; and

**WHEREAS**, Chapter 111 of the Code contains certain parking restrictions; and


**WHEREAS**, the Borough desires to appoint an individual to the position of Parking Code Enforcement Officer to enforce and administer the parking restrictions in Chapter 111 of the Code, as amended from time to time; and

**WHEREAS**, Council for the Borough is confident that Bradford T. Flynn, the Borough Manager, will competently handle the enforcement and administrative functions for the parking restrictions required by Chapter 111 of the Code, as amended from time to time.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED,** by Council of the Borough of Bath, that Bradford T. Flynn, the Borough Manager, is hereby appointed as a Parking Code Enforcement Officer on behalf of the Borough of Bath, and is vested with all rights, power and authority which inure to that position to enforce and administer the parking restrictions of Chapter 111 of the Code, as amended from time to time.
