Park & Recreation Improvements

Improvements to the ballfields, flower beds, mulch beds and general repairs throughout the Borough's 34 acres of park network totaled **\$17,404.10** in 2022. Improvements also include new walking trail concepts at Fire Fighter's Field, Cliff Cowling Field, among other parks, which is planned to become an interconnected trail system in the future.

Major Parks & Recreation Upgrades

Park equipment upgrades occurred at Fire Field, with the installation of new playground equipment. New camera systems were installed in Ciff Cowling, Monocacy Creek Park, and Keystone Park. Increased lighting was installed at Ciff Cowling Field and Firefighter's Park. Park equipment upgrades totaled **\$70,774.57**.
