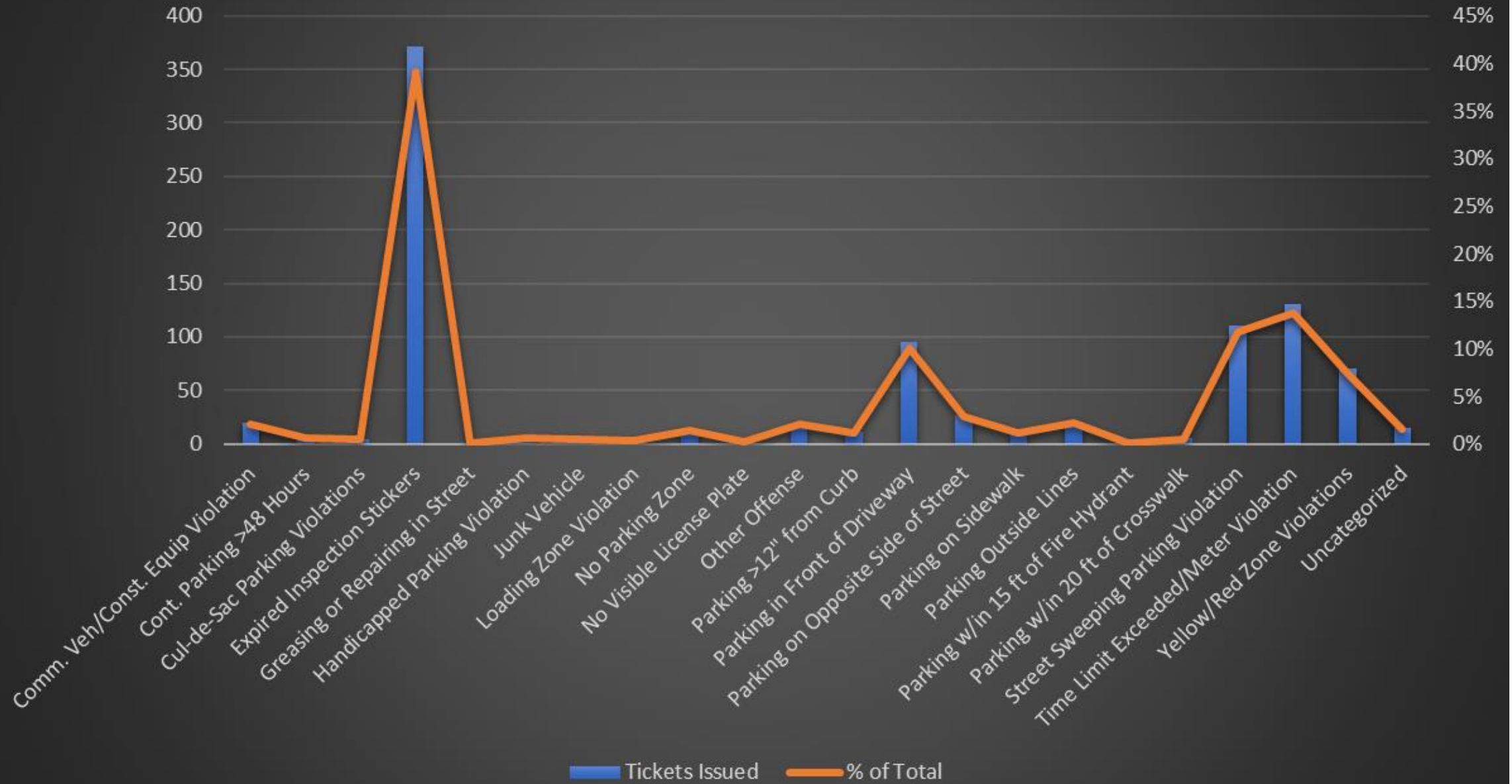


Figure 2 – 2022 Bath Parking Enforcement by Violation Type and Percentage of Total Violations

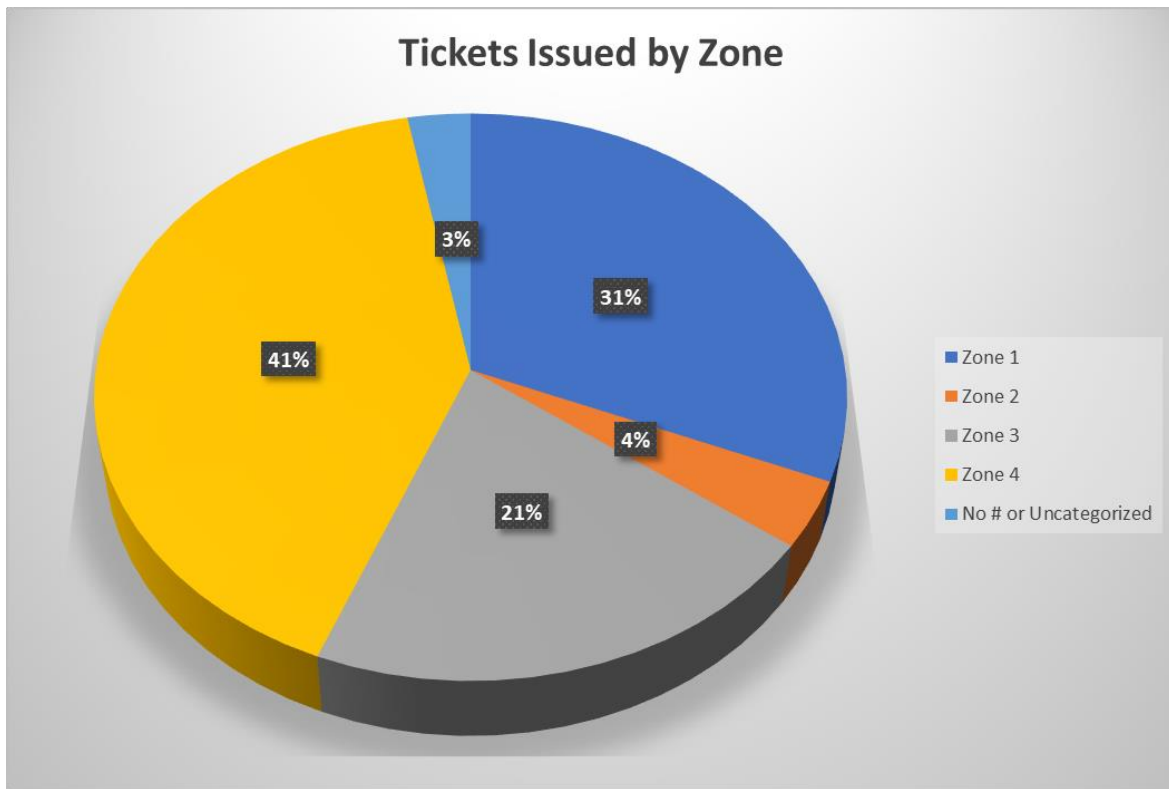


Figure 3 – Parking Tickets issued by Borough Zones

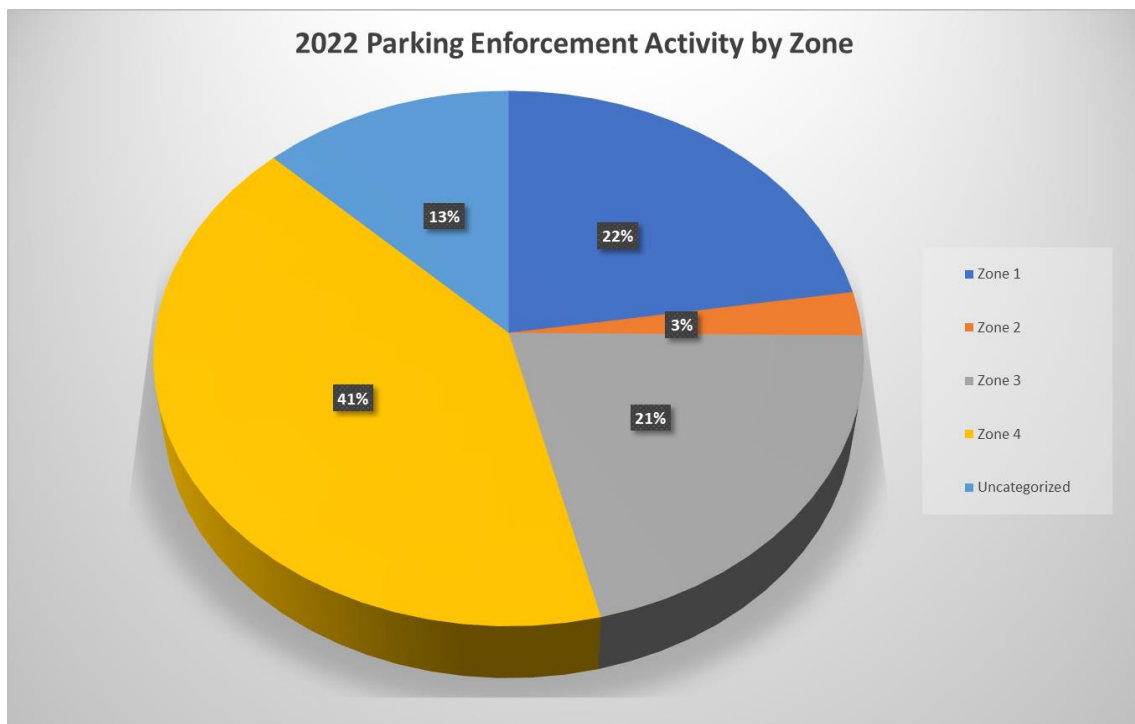


Figure 4 – 2022 Parking Enforcement Activity/Incidents by Zone

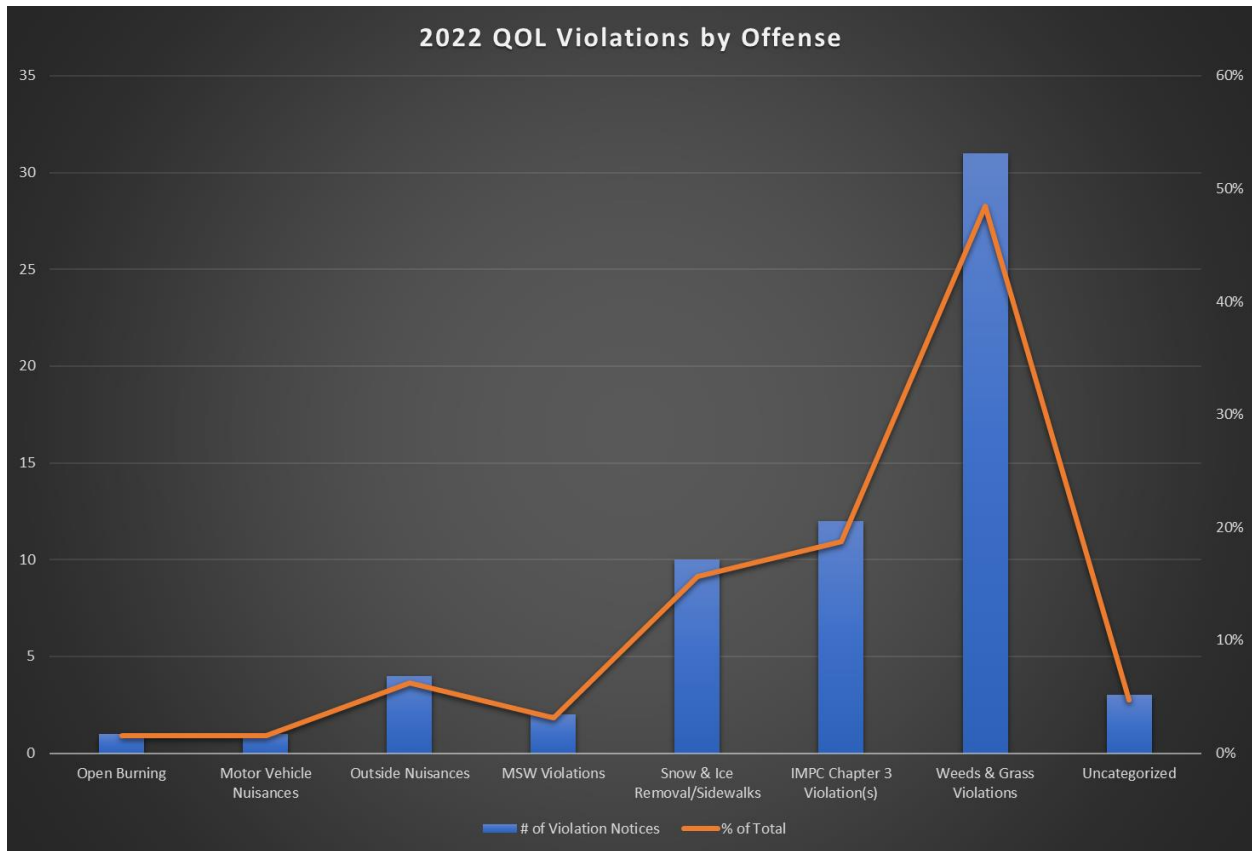


Figure 6 – QOL Violations by Offense and Percentage of Total

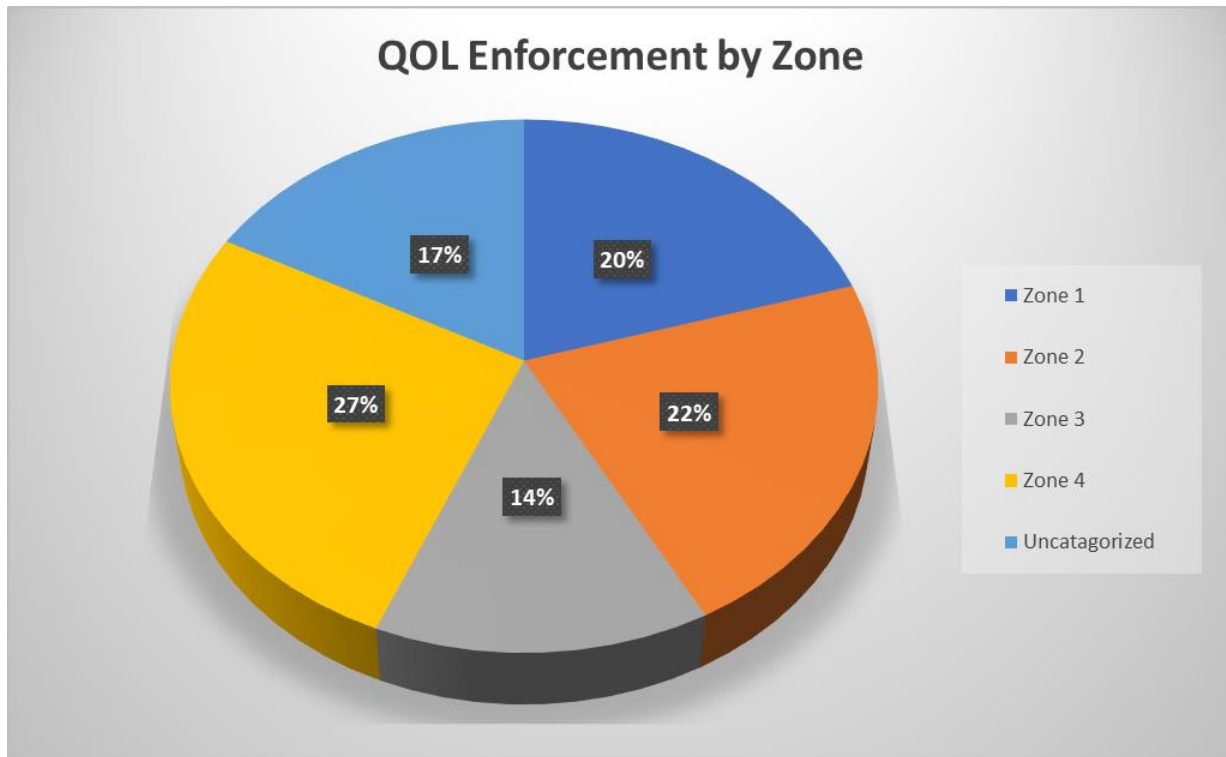


Figure 7 – QOL Enforcement Activity by Borough Zone

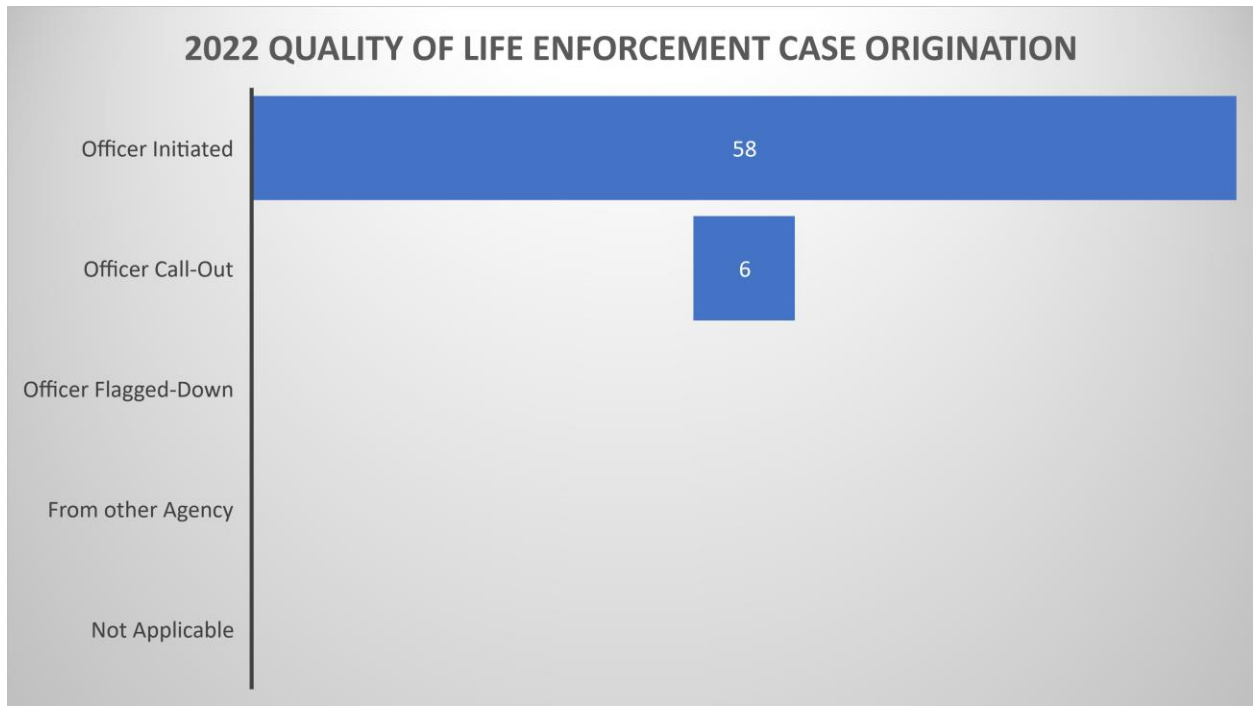


Figure 8 – Quality of Life Enforcement Case Origination Funnel

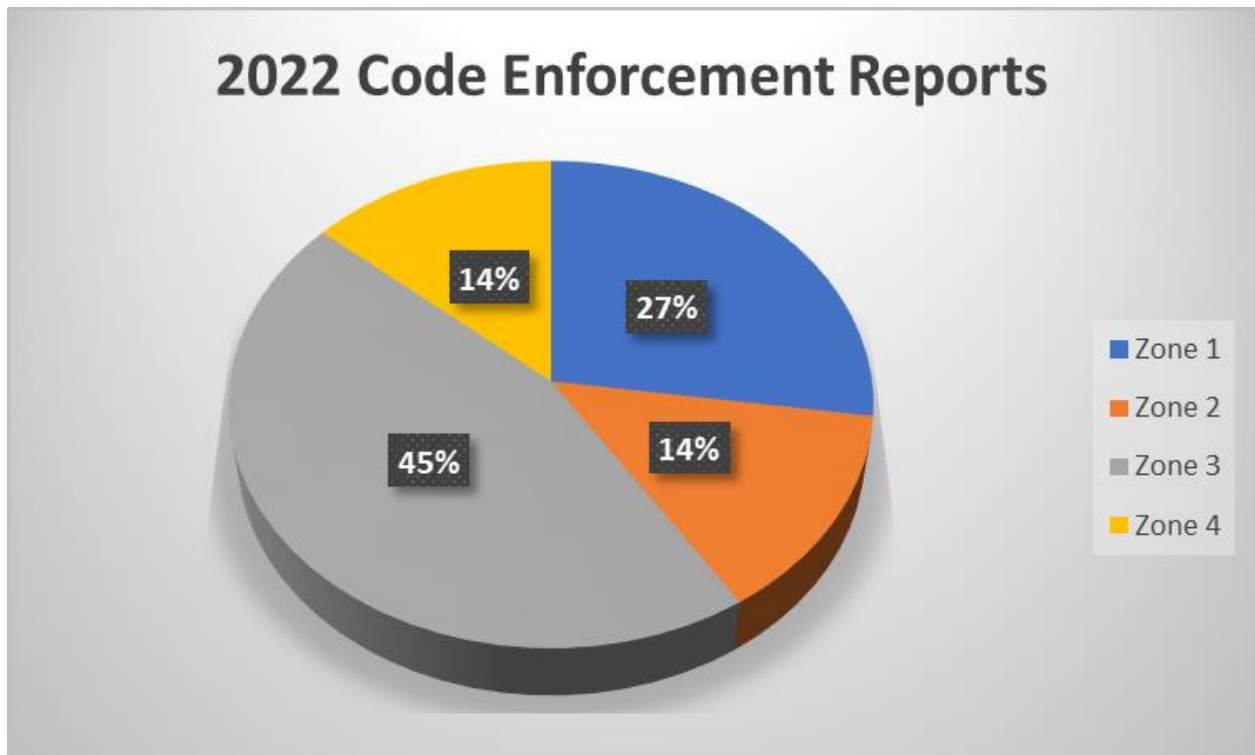


Figure 9 – Code Enforcement Reports & Incidents by Zone
