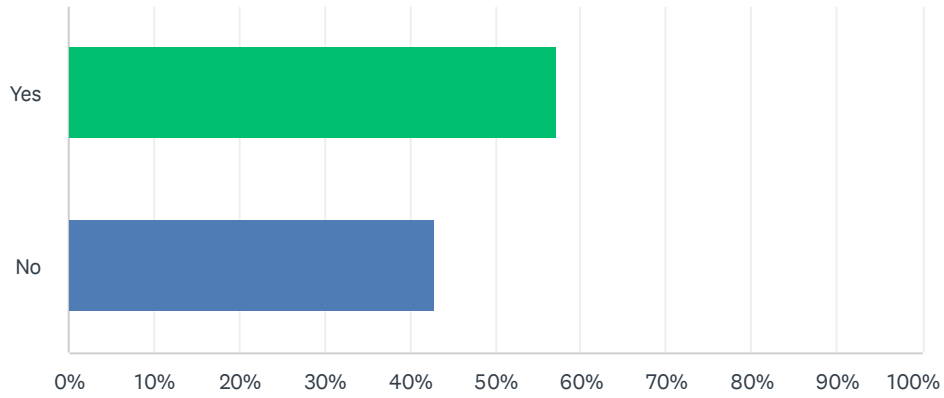

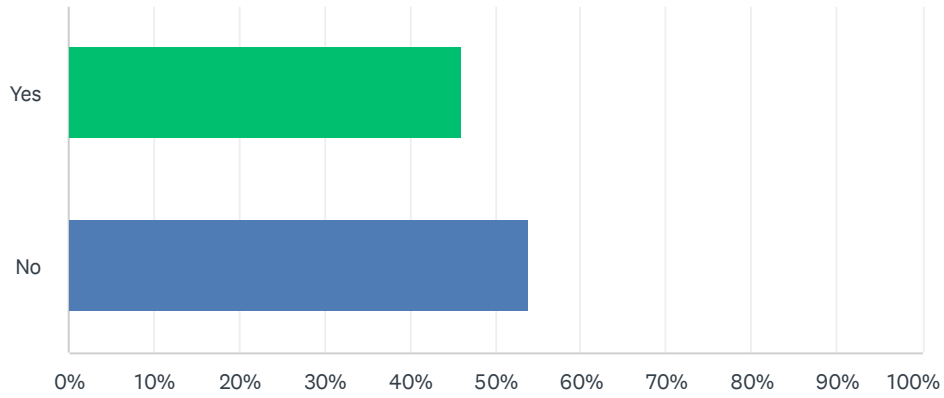

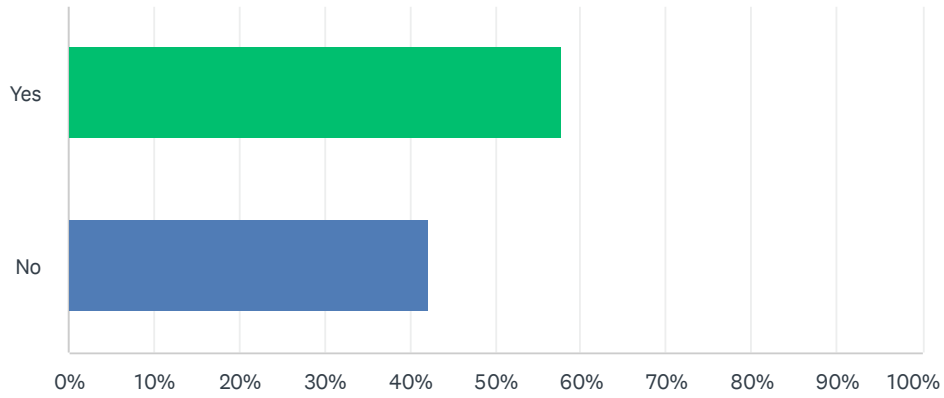

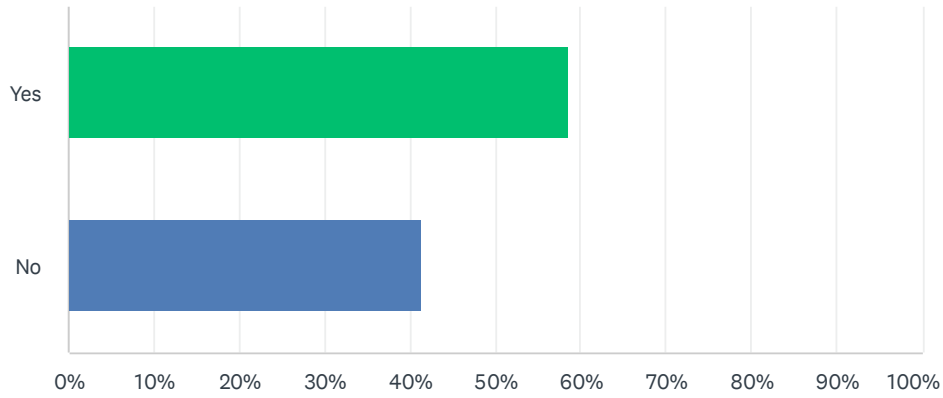

Q7 Prior to July 1, 2018, had you ever summoned the Colonial Regional Police for any reason?

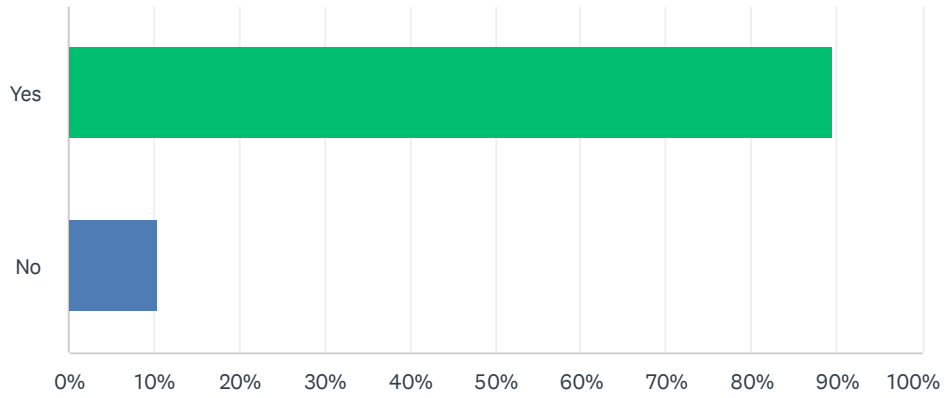

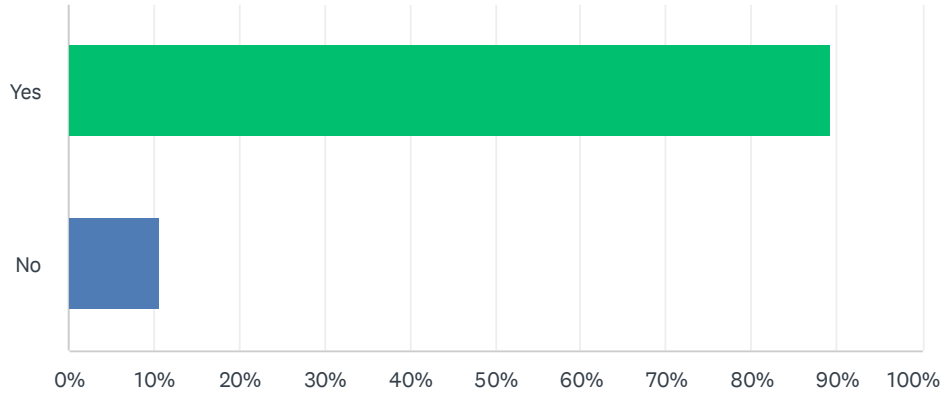

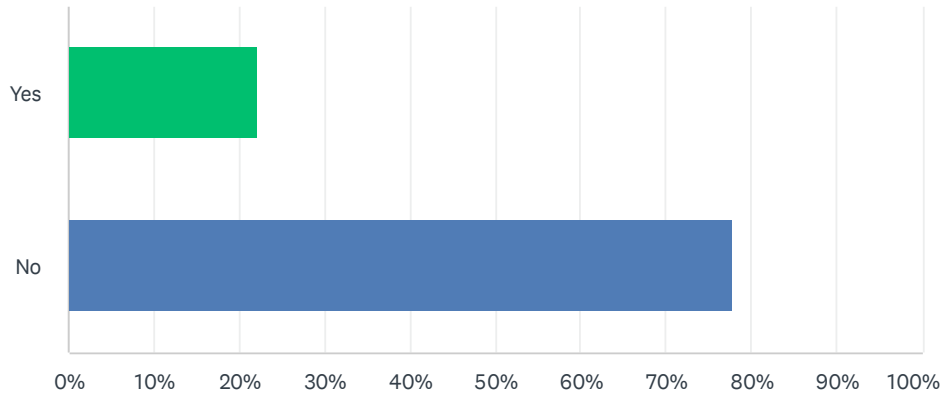

Q12 Prior to 1995, had you ever summoned the Bath Borough Police for any reason?

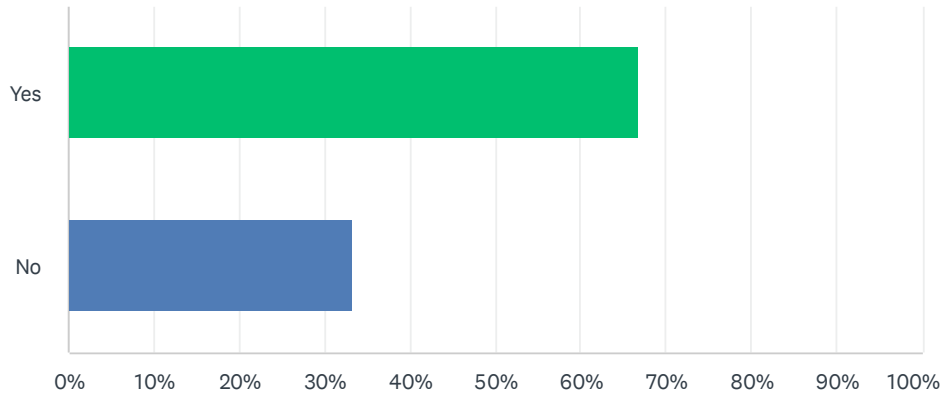

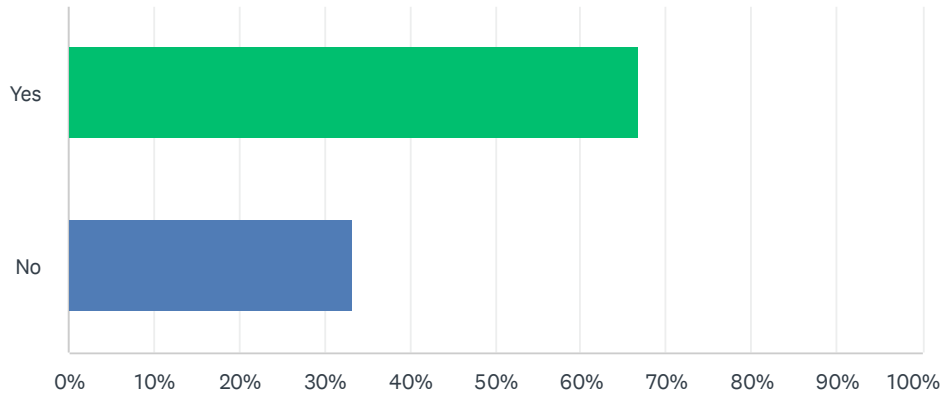

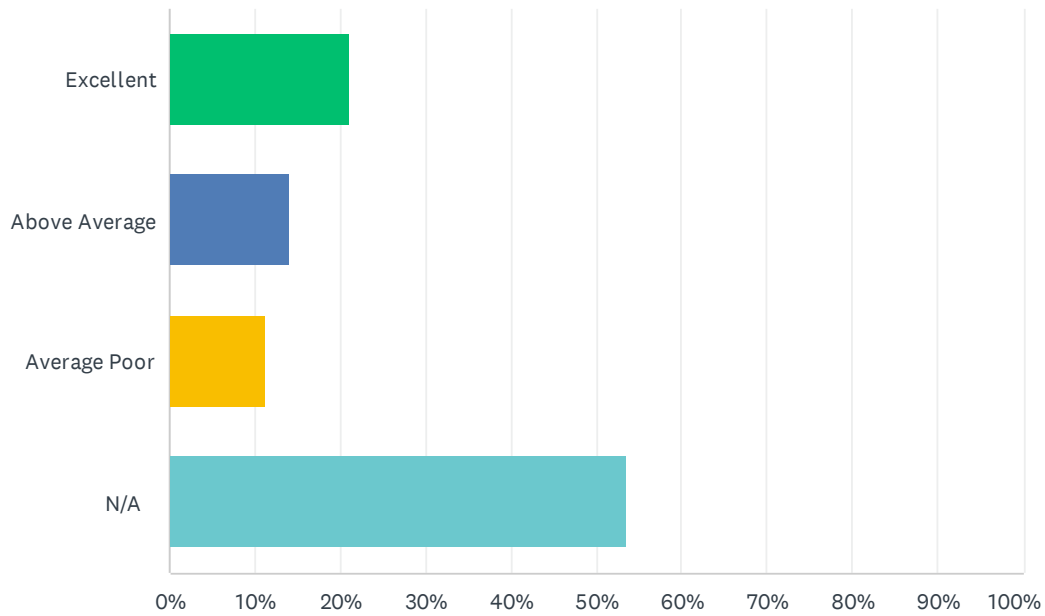

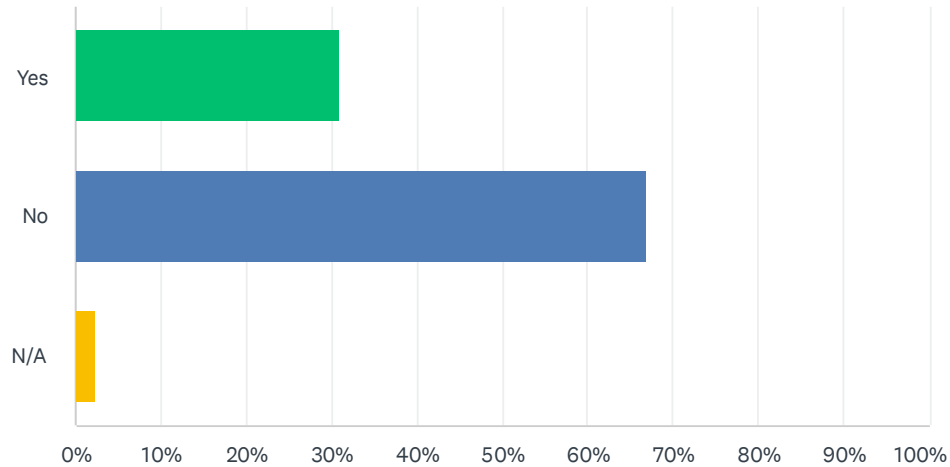

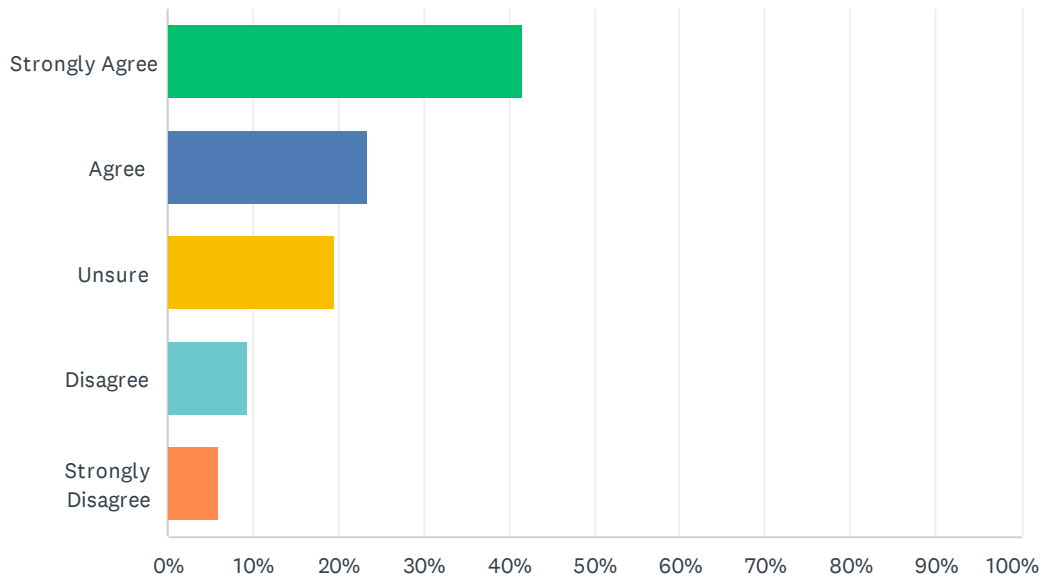

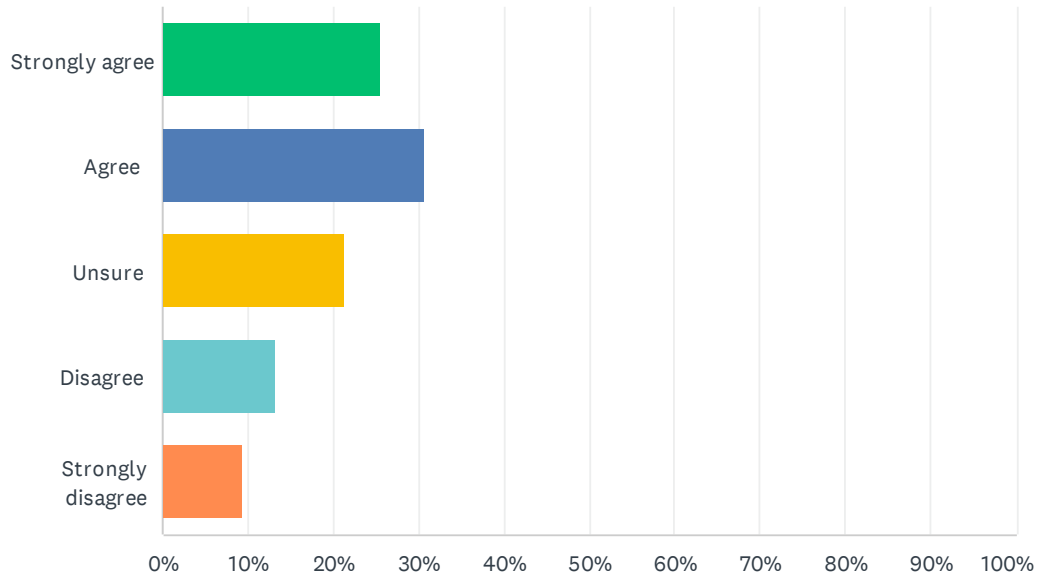

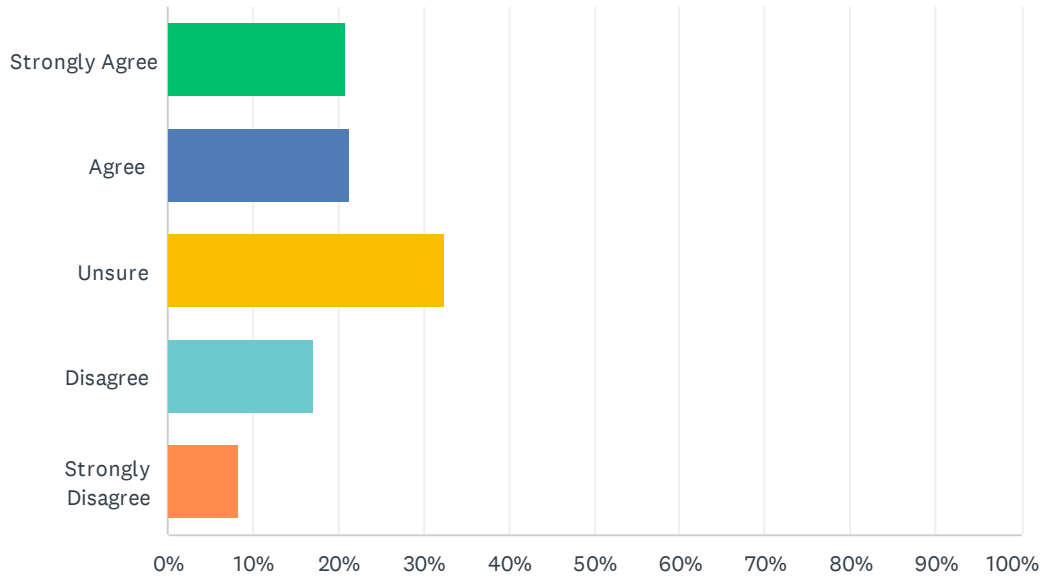

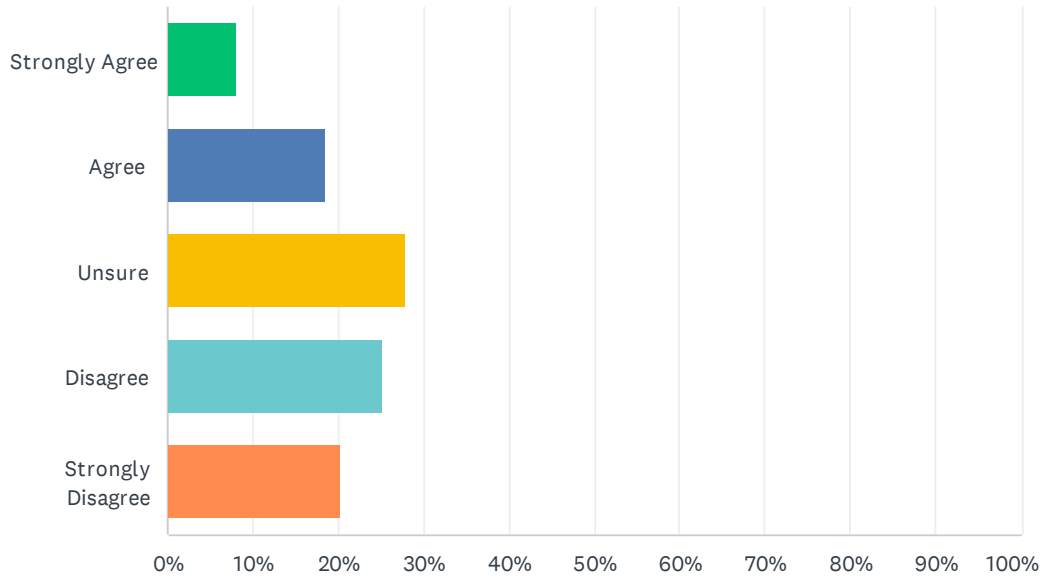

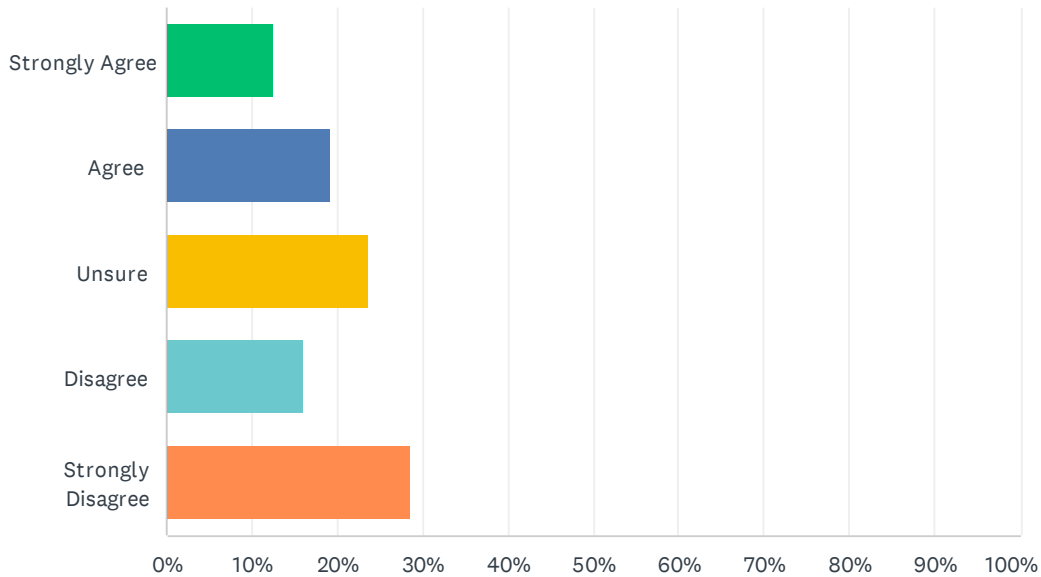

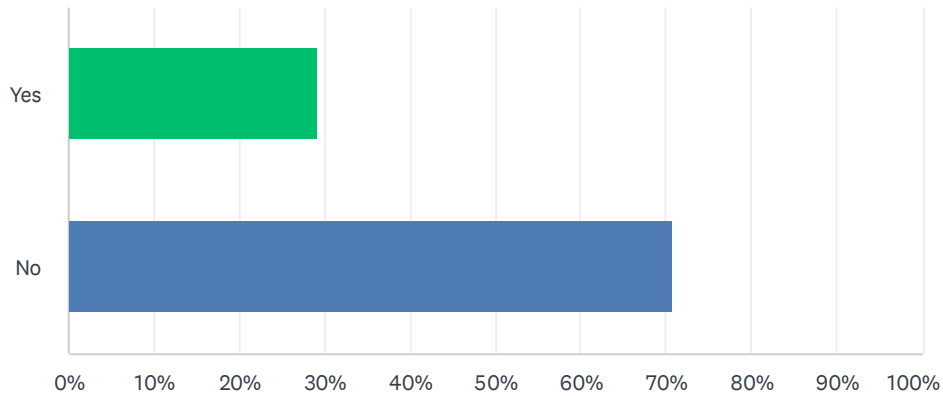
