### MEETING MINUTES:

- Engineer Madison brought committee up to speed regarding the Borough's NPDES permit, and Pollution Reduction Plan (PRP). Bath's annual MS4 report has been submitted.
- Engineer Madison gave overview of MS4 program goals and rough outline of timeline.
  1. Discussed Fountain Hill Borough MS4 example/model program. Provided the committee Fountain Hill Borough's ordinance.
- Committee discussed an MS4 - Stormwater Fee program that could be implemented sometime in 2025 at the earliest. Fees will be required to handle capital construction and ongoing operational maintenance of the Borough's storm sewer system.
  1. Fountain Hill: uses an average impervious coverage system to establish a 'base unit'. Fountain Hill charges approximately \$20 per quarter in storm sewer fees.
- Engineer Madison was going to do some additional research on MS4 programs in the Lehigh Valley and report back to the committee during September's meeting.
