Geoffrey Buffington in 2018 Councilwoman Anderson resigned from borough council. They immediately announced they would advertise the position and hold interviews the very next month. Which they did. At that time they choose current council president Frank Hesch. In October 2021, Mark Saginario resigned from council, there was no announcement, no advertising of the position and no interviews. What there was, was an email by a highly concerned mayor to council. (Mind you that filling the council seat is solely the responsibility and a vote conducted only by council. The mayor has zero say). Yet she wanted to let everyone know that her husband was interested in the seat. This email was highly improper. As it came to be that seat vacancy was only announced in January of 2022 towards the very end of meeting and immediately without any interviews or advertisement, given to her husband.

In the course of everything I was looking into this came to my attention. Because the timing falls inline with what I was investigating. The conversation when viewed in light of what I suspected. Is very concerning.

State law lays out the process of replacing a council member. This makes it procedural or factual in nature. Attorney client privilege does not cover something that is procedural or factual in nature and the borough solicitor had numerous conversations with Bradford Flynn between October and December of 2021 regarding that council seat. It is these communications which the PA department of Open Records determined not once but twice should be handed over as part of my Open records request. It is this that the borough filed 3 separate appeals against. Unfortunately council still buys the BS being pitched to them. The law is on my side and on top of it the only reason to try and keep such communications private can only be the cover up of a potential crime. Which attorney client privilege also doesn't protect. Do you thing me releasing this report at 5pm today was coincidental and I didn't release part 2 because that goes to the judge tomorrow and ties part 1 into a much deeper dive and issues not covered here. The amount of criminal activity is profound and truth my friend shall prevail.
