



¹ A motion for reconsideration “is addressed to the sound discretion of the trial court.” Moore v. Moore, 634 A.2d 163, 166 (Pa. 1993). Here, Defendant’s Motion for Reconsideration is largely a regurgitation of the arguments he presented in his earlier Motion for Appointment of Court Experts, which the Court denied in its Opinion and Order dated October 23, 2024. Defendant does not identify any legal error, change in controlling law, consequential newly-discovered evidence, or other basis justifying reconsideration. Accordingly, Defendant’s motion is denied.
