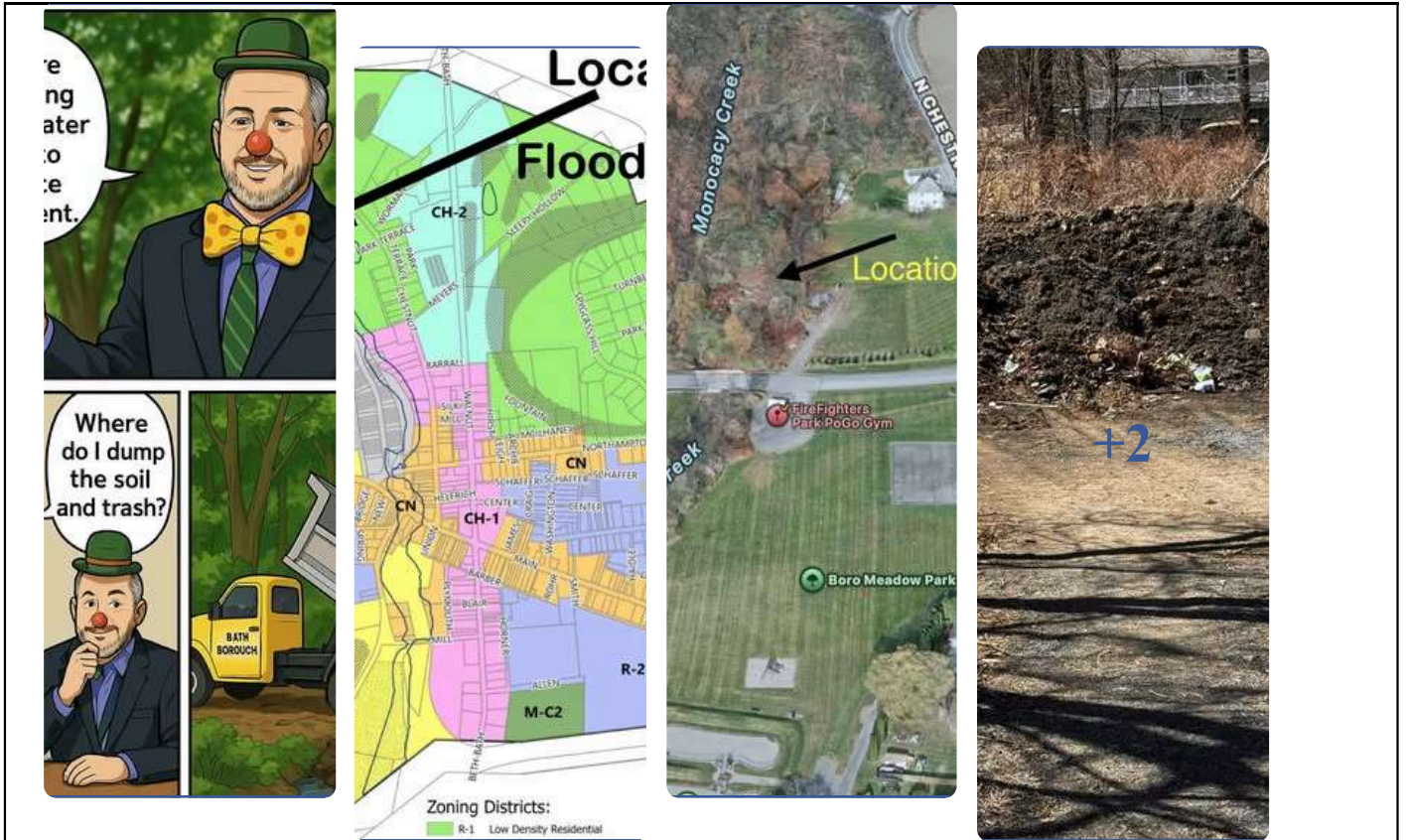

BREAKING: BATH BOROUGH MANAGER CAUGHT IN REPEAT ENVIRONMENTAL VIOLATION—AND HE MUST BE TERMINATED IMMEDIATELY

At 1:12 PM today, I caught a Bath Borough Public Works dump truck illegally dumping contaminated soil and household trash—including a gallon jug of Clorox bleach—into a designated floodplain at 400 N Chestnut St, next to Firefighter Park

A site where the Borough was fined for exact same behavior in 2022.

This isn't just incompetence.

This is a repeat violation by the very people tasked with protecting our community and environment.

WHO'S RESPONSIBLE?

- Bradford T. Flynn, Borough Manager and Floodplain Administrator
- Legally responsible for overseeing floodplain protection
- Direct supervisor of Public Works (who did the dumping)

- Already fined once under his watch for this exact same offense

And now he's done it again.

According to Flynn's own employment contract, this qualifies for immediate termination "for cause" due to:

- Willful misconduct
- Conduct that jeopardizes the Borough's best interests
- Repeated failure to perform duties responsibly
- Material breach of his job responsibilities as Floodplain Administrator

This is a legal, environmental, and ethical crisis.

Meanwhile, these same officials created a Stormwater Authority to:

- Demand over \$250,000 in fees starting next week
- Borrow up to \$1 million to reduce "sediment" in Monocacy Creek—a creek they are actively polluting.

And now they want us to pay for the cleanup?

Council has a choice to make:

1. Terminate Bradford Flynn immediately for cause, or
2. Be complicit in his misconduct.

Anything short of his removal is an insult to every resident and a dereliction of duty by Borough Council.

Overlooking this repeated, documented violation would in itself be criminal.

This is not a political issue. This is a community issue.

We, the residents of Bath, demand the following:

- Immediate termination of Bradford T. Flynn
- A formal investigation into the Public Works Department's operations
- A public commitment to environmental compliance going forward

If Council fails to act, they are no longer representing us.

We will not pay for corruption.
