More specifically, what does RTK Corpus actually automate today? Does it ingest RTKL requests, agency responses, OOR docket materials, Final Determinations, court opinions, or other records and then assist with research, drafting, citation analysis, or preparation of filings?

I'm asking because you've obviously put some thought into this, and the materials you sent over regarding 400 N. Chestnut look substantially more structured than ordinary AI-assisted drafting.

And you still managed to dance around my original question. 😊 Has any Bath Borough RTKL material been used as source material, testing material, training material, or other input for RTK Corpus or the larger stack you referenced?
